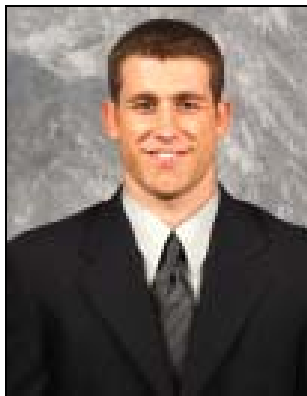

Currently coaching at Brown University as an assistant coach; serves as the recruiting coordinator and works with the upper weights... previously coached 2 years at Lehigh University and one year at Stanford... second in a line of three brothers who have wrestled for Ohio State... 4X NCAA qualifier... 2X NCAA All-American... 2X Big Ten Championship runner-up... only ninth Buckeye to become multi All-American... senior season team leader with 163 takedowns which ranked 4th all time in Ohio State history... senior season team best and career high 40 wins... ranked fourth in career wins with 134... ranked third all-time in takedowns (486) and in team points (432) 432... joined teammate Tommy Rowlands and former Buckeye Adam DiSabato as the only OSU wrestlers to reach 400 career takedowns and 400 team points... topped over 100 takedowns and 30 wins in each of his last three seasons...

Emergency Medical Authorization

Section 3313.712, Ohio Revised Code

Purpose: To enable parents/guardians to authorize the provisions of emergency treatment for children who become ill or injured while under school authority, when parents/guardians can not be reached.

Part I or Part II must be completed

Part I – To Grant Consent

I hereby give consent for the following medical care providers and local hospital to be called:

In the event reasonable attempts to contact me have been unsuccessful, I hereby give consent for (1) the administrator of any treatment deemed necessary, or, in the event the designated referred practitioner is not available, by another licensed physician or dentist; and (2) the transfer of another child to preferred hospital or any hospital reasonable accessible. This authorization does not cover major surgery unless the medical opinions of two other licensed physicians or dentist, concurring in the necessity for such surgery, are obtained prior to the performance of such surgery. Facts concerning the child's medical history including allergies, medications being taken, and any physical impairments to which a physician should be alerted.

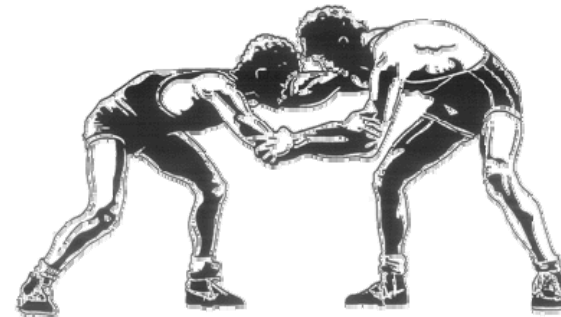
